It has come to our attention that your service currently located on **theworldnews**[REDACTED] is making reproductions of news articles belonging to Berlingske Media A/S (bt.dk), JP/Politikens Hus A/S (politiken.dk, ekstrabladet.dk, finans.dk), NORDJYSKE Medier A/S (nordjyske.dk), Jysk Fynske Medier P/S (jv.dk), Information A/S (information.dk) and Avisen.dk ApS (avisen.dk) and making these reproductions available to the public on theworldnews[REDACTED] without the consent of the copyrights holders.
