**ERRATA TO THE
SECOND
SUPPLEMENTAL
DECLARATION OF BOB
BRASICH**

I, Bob Brasich, declare and state as follows:

1. I am a licensed private investigator employed as the President and Owner of The Internet Investigators, a private investigative firm located in San Diego, California. I previously submitted declarations in this matter, one dated February 3, 2017 (the "First Brasich Declaration"), another dated February 16, 2017 (the "Supplemental Brasich Declaration"), and, most recently, one dated February 24, 2017 (the "Second Supplemental Brasich Declaration"). The instant declaration is intended to correct a typographical error made in paragraph 8 of the Second Supplemental Brasich Declaration. As before, the statements made in this declaration are based on my personal knowledge.

2. In paragraph 8 of the Second Supplemental Brasich Declaration, I discussed my recent observations regarding the websites that Defendants use to host the in-page video player for the PubFilm Websites. Specifically, I explained that Defendants' in-page video player was previously hosted on the subdomain Player.Pubfilm.com, which itself was hosted in two physical locations, one on a server provided by DigitalOcean, Inc. and another on a server provided by Vultr Holdings, LLC via Choopa LLC. I provided the internet protocol ("IP") addresses for both the DigitalOcean server and the Vultr/Choopa server; and I explained that, as of February 22, 2017, the in-page video player for the PubFilm site was still hosted at these locations using these same IP addresses, but the subdomain name had been changed to Player.Pub77.com for both the Digital Ocean server and the Vultr/Choopa server. Additionally, I stated that a similarly-named subdomain Player.Pubfilm.ac, while not actively used, was also hosted at these same IP addresses.

3. I discovered yesterday, March 5, 2017, that the IP address for the Vultr/Choopa server as stated in paragraph 8 of the Second Supplemental Brasich Declaration contained a typographical error. The Second Supplemental Brasich Declaration stated that the IP address for the Vultr/Choopa server was 108.61.191.114. However, the correct IP address for the Vultr/Choopa server in question is in fact 108.61.191.141, a transposition of the final two digits. The IP address for the DigitalOcean server (104.131.114.73) was accurately stated in paragraph 8 of the Second Supplemental Brasich Declaration and needs no correction. The subdomain name Player.Pub77.com was also correctly stated in that paragraph of the Second Supplemental Brasich Declaration and, by itself, is sufficient for Vultr/Choopa to have identified the server and website in question, even without reference to the IP address.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States of America that the foregoing is true and correct.
